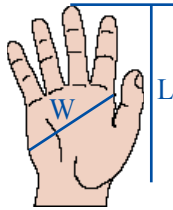

Government Agencies: Net 30 terms from date of shipment on any or all items shipped on order. This includes partial shipments. A 1 1/2%/mo. (18% annual) charge will be assessed on accounts over 30 days. Please call to set up an account.

Shipping Information: U.P.S. is our primary shipper. Some items which exceed U.P.S. size limitations can only be shipped by motor freight. Please call for these shipping costs. If we are not furnished a street address, shipment will have to be made by Parcel post. U.P.S. will not ship to a P.O. Box. We may also ship books by Parcel Post.

Shipping and Handling Charges: U.P.S. within Continental U.S.: 6% of merchandise subtotal with a \$8.50 minimum. U.S. Mail: Actual freight. Some items require extra freight.

Special Orders: We will gladly special order merchandise not carried in our stock from our vendors. Materials made up to order and cut lengths are not returnable. A restocking charge of 20% will be assessed if you find it necessary to return a special ordered item.

Back orders: We do our best to prevent back orders, however occasionally they are unavoidable.

Returns and Exchanges: If you wish to return an unused item within thirty days of receiving it for refund or exchange, please (1) call for
